









SUSTAINABLE INTERACTION AT SEED

Renew your outlook with a tour of permaculture at SEED's Urban Abundance Centre in Mitchells Plain, a suburb on the Cape Flats. Here, you'll witness an empowered community that is driven by sustainability, resilience and social cohesion. The Cape Flats' residents span the rainbow nation of cultures, religions and ethnic diversity. Together, they form a powerful force that cultivates a better tomorrow.

Visit the centre, which integrates schools-based outdoor classrooms, youth development and career pathing, as well as enterprise and skills development. It also houses a nursery and seed bank and supports 100 local home food gardens.

Highlights: A two-hour tour of Rocklands Urban Abundance Centre which includes Outdoor Classrooms, a post-carbon homestead model, the community enterprise Gourmet Mushroom project and the integrated and abundant sustainable agriculture systems.

FORAGING TOUR

There's nothing like harvesting the goodness of nature and using the absolute freshest ingredients to define a dish. The Cape's exquisite ecosystem boasts a diverse array of native plants that together form the ultimate storehouse. Jam-packed with a sense of adventurous interaction, these expeditions will endow you with sought-after knowledge on harnessing the fruits of our natural surroundings, to present culinary visions.

Depending on what is available in nature's larder, foragers are taken on informative and scenic tours of some of Cape Town's beautiful areas. Each experience is unique. Foragers are then invited to venture into the kitchen to learn more about preparing food using their harvests.

WINELANDS TOUR

Enjoy gorgeous wines, refined to meet your personal taste, from the epicentre of global award-winning wines and sumptuous haute cuisine – the world-renowned Cape Winelands.
